Prof. Sarah Griffith is an Associate Professor of History at Queens University of Charlotte. She's currently teaching at Tsuda University and Tokyo University of Foreign Studies as a Fulbright Visiting Lecturer. Her first book explored the role liberal Protestant activists played in the fight for Asian American civil rights across the early 20th century. More recently, she has been looking into the social and organizational networks American and Japanese Christian women built in the pre-WWI era. This new research will be the focus of this lecture.
